The course also encourages experimentation with space, form, and function to create clean, distraction-free visual designs. Participants will gain practical experience in research and planning by following a typical UX design workflow and applying concepts to their app ideas.

No prior experience in UX or design is required. This workshop is ideal for designers, developers, business analysts, and program managers looking to enhance their understanding of UX design.
